

# INSTRUCTION

GRAYED AREAS ARE FOR EMBRYO TRANSPLANT CALVES ONLY

- A** Place no more than **one** letter or number in each block for the animal's name. Each space between names is counted as one letter.  
If an animal is an import, the registration certificate from the country of export must accompany this application.
- B** Place identification number Tattooed or Firebranded on animal for your identification in blocks provided. Leave blank or unneeded spaces, if any, at left side of block.
- C** Describe the location of the identification number on the animal (one letter per block). (RH right hip, LH left hip, RR right rib, LR left rib, RS right shoulder, LS left shoulder, RE right ear, LE left ear).
- F** "In-Herd-A.I." applies if you own an interest in the sire or have a lease. "Out-of-Herd A.I." applies if you do not own an interest in the sire. In this case, you are required to **obtain either a semen transfer or** the signature of the owner of the sire on the application, unless the dam was transferred with service.
- G** Check "Purebred Registration" if the animal to be registered is 31/32 or more Charolais. You must indicate the percentage of Charolais blood  /  % for 7/8 or  /  % for 15 / 16 and so forth, and the percentage other (Angus  /  % for example). These fractions must total one (1), e.g.  $1/2 + 1/2=1$ ,  $3/4+1/4=1$ ,  $3/4+1/8+1/8=1$ ,  $15/16+1/16=1$ ,  $15/16+1/32+1/32=1$ , etc.
- H** Must check one:  
Horned: horn growth connected to skull.  
Dehorned: original firm horn growth removed.  
Scurs: horn growth not firmly attached to the skull.  
Polled: complete absence of horn growth.
- I J** Select one of the five (5) colors given instead of "other" if at all possible. **Only white, light cream or light straw are acceptable for purebred registration.**
- K** Only pink or light colors are acceptable for purebred registration. Dark noses are acceptable on Charolais-crosses and red animals.
- L M** Self Explanatory
- N** Place your breeder number e.g.      or      etc., using one block for each number.
- O** Transfer of animal being registered must include date of delivery AND full name and address of buyer (please print). If buyer's breeder number is known, please put in space provided.
- P** Check one for mailing instructions.
