- Serve on a committee.
- Maintain regular correspondence with their area.

- Forego public uses of alcoholic beverages, tobacco and illegal drugs at all times during AIJCA or associated Charolais activities, regardless of your age.
- Serve as a member of a team, always maintaining a cooperative attitude.
